MEMBERSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- Financial management or financing for grantmakers and nonprofits.

Disqualifying factors include but are not limited to:

- Vendors who provide or sell products to grantmakers and nonprofits;
- Single source consultants for whom more than 80% of their business is one activity (i.e. vendors and technical consultants);

Final approval of applicant members is made by The Center's Engagement Committee and is based on the applicant's fit with the eligibility criteria stated above. GCG does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, age, disability or any other legally protected characteristics.
