- Adhere to any and all Internal Revenue Service codes relating to foundations, individuals, or other grantmaking organizations that carry out charitable activities;
- Commit to equal opportunity practices in hiring and grantmaking.

*Solicitation includes but is not limited to: use of member contacts to promote and/or direct ask for business or funding and/or engaging in those types of activities during Center events and programs.
